

Topic/art challenge

CHALLENGE: Capture the signs of spring in a collage of images.



What are the signs of spring? Buds on trees, full of new leaves ready to burst out? The first flowers peeping through the soil or the brave pioneering insects searching for some nectar? There are lots of things that we can enjoy when we notice the changing of winter to spring. Your challenge is to capture these and share them.

How can I do this?

Go outside (if permission is given) and look around for signs of spring and new growth. You can either draw what you see and make a collage of drawings or download an app such as Pic Collage (with permission) and use a digital device to capture and create your composition.

Finally, upload this to See Saw to share.

How can I be successful?

- Consider how your subjects fill your canvas/frame to create an interesting composition. Choose the focal point carefully.
- If using a digital camera, apply the Macro setting so you can get even closer and capture tiny details.
- Draw or photograph lots of images so you can select the best for your final collage.

Topic/ geography challenge

CHALLENGE: draw a sketch map of your street/ surrounding area.

Starting with your house in the middle, consider local landmarks, buildings, roads, wildlife areas, road names, shops, train lines. Don't forget to label your map.

Take a photograph and share your sketch map on Seesaw.

Please note: You could use google satellite to help with this, although some images may be outdated/ new houses may not be visible. Also, if you have been advised to stay indoors, please do so for the safety of yourselves and others.
