Monday	<p>Can listen to a story and ask and answer questions about the book?</p> <p>Can I learn about different materials?</p>	<p>Messy Magpie – ebook. Show your child the cover of the story and ask them what they think it might be about. Look at the details on the cover do they know what type of bird it is? What can they see all around the bird? Read the story to your child.</p> <p>Can your child remember what happened at the beginning of the story the middle and the end? What did they like about the story? What does the story help us learn about? Do you know what recycling is? Do you recycle at home?</p> <p>You can then use the ‘Materials’ PowerPoint to discuss different types of materials can your child find/identify any if these materials in your home? Can they discuss what the different materials can be used to make?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Can I listen to the story?</p> <p>Can I identify what various objects are made from?</p>	<p>Recap the learning from yesterday and read the book again.</p> <p>Use the ‘What am I made from?’ PowerPoint (as it is a PDF you will need to use your hand or some paper to cover up the answer)</p>
Wednesday	<p>Can listen to a story and ask and answer questions about the book?</p> <p>Can I learn about recycling?</p>	<p>Read ‘The Messy Magpie’ talk about the story and how all the animals helped each other. Encourage your child to ask and answer questions about the story.</p> <p>Use the ‘All about Recycling’ PowerPoint. Keep asking questions to extend your child’s understanding.</p> <p>Can your child help you with the recycling at home? Can they help keep the environment tidy, when out for your daily exercise can they take a bag and find any rubbish to tidy to help the animals?</p>
Thursday	<p>Can I help to retell the story?</p> <p>Can I learn about why litter is damaging to the environment?</p>	<p>Read ‘The Messy Magpie’ again and ask your child to help you read it this time so they can begin to retell the story.</p> <p>Use the ‘Litter and the Environment’ PowerPoint.</p>
Friday	<p>What has your child found challenging this week? What do they need to continue learning? Discuss the learning from the week. Can your child answer any questions about why we recycle? Can they talk about the story and what it teaches us?</p>	<p>Time to exercise and relax with a Cosmic kid’s yoga story adventure! (These can be found on YouTube and is great for everyone!) They also have zen dens, peace out and mindfulness that your child may enjoy accessing throughout the week.</p>
