### Daily Practise and Extra Opportunities

- You should listen to your child read for at least 20 minutes **every day**. You could share a story together. This could be a chapter book, where you read and discuss a chapter a day. Listen to your child read and let them discuss what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.

- Your child should be practising X Tables for 10 minutes every day. Practise 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 times tables. You could do this by singing the songs, filling out X-Table wheels within a minute, filling out a blank Multiplication Grid, having a competition with playing cards (first to multiply two cards together).

- Visit Maths Frame - Multiplication Check to practise for the Year 4 Check later in June. Make sure your child adjusts the settings to a 6-second timer. Can they beat their personal best? <https://mathsframe.co.uk/>

### English

- Write a short story as a family. Take it in turns to write a line each, and see where the story takes you!
- Guess What - pick an object you can see. Can your family ask you closed questions to guess what your object is? You can only answer yes or no! Take it in turns to guess.
- Draw a front cover of a book you have read. Think about what could have happened in the story judging by the book cover. Can you change the story to match it? You MUST NOT re-write the same story-line. Come up with a new story and write it in your Reading Journal. Don't forget; you need an introduction, build-up, problem, resolution and ending
