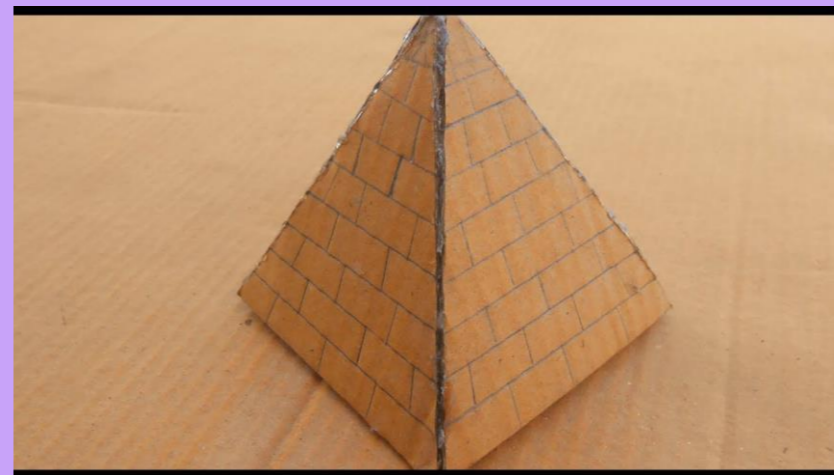
#### Make a papyrus
