<u>Times Tables</u>	Your child should be practising X Tables for 10-15 minutes every day. Practise 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 times tables. <b>We now have Times Table Rockstars! Your log-in details have been sent to you via Seesaw. Start off by practising your times tables, then test yourself on 'Soundcheck'.</b> You could also practise by singing the songs, filling out X-Table wheels within a minute, filling out a blank Multiplication Grid, having a competition with playing cards (first to multiply two cards together). <b>The aim to have a quick recall of multiplication facts.</b> - Visit Maths Frame - Multiplication Check to practise for the Year 4 Check later in June. 
## Topic
