<u>Times Tables</u>	You should be practising X Tables for 10-15 minutes every day. Practise 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 times tables. Practise using Times Table Rockstars! Your log-in details have been sent to you via Seesaw. Start off by practising your times tables, then test yourself on 'Soundcheck'. You could also practise by singing the songs, filling out X-Table wheels within a minute, filling out a blank Multiplication Grid, having a competition with playing cards (first to multiply two cards together). The aim to have a quick recall of multiplication facts. - Visit Maths Frame - Multiplication Check to practise for the Year 4 Check later in June.
