Topic	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Think back to the work you did last week on the different parts of a tree. Can you find out about the different jobs that each part of the tree has? Why is the trunk important? What is the purpose of the leaves? Why do trees need roots?</li> <li>How many different types of trees are in your local area or a specific place that you can visit? On a walk, keep a tally for the different types of tree that you see. Analyse the data. Which tree is most common? Which tree is the rarest? How did you know how to identify the trees?</li> </ol>
