
1. At the start the story takes place at Jim's house.

## Plant:




**Pollen**  
Powdery substance which creates seeds.

**Leaves**  
Collect energy from the sun and make food.

**Roots**  
Absorb water and minerals from soil and anchors the plant to the ground.

**Stem**  
Supports the plant and carries water to the leaves.


