CHARLES II

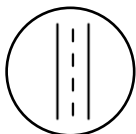
King at the time

Runs through London. People used it to escape.

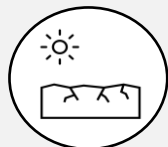


ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL:

WHEN?



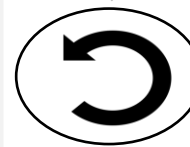
SUN 2ND SEPT 1666
Fire starts @ 1am
Mayor back to bed



MON 3RD SEPT 1666
Fire seen from Oxford (60 miles away)



TUES 4TH SEPT 1666
St Paul's destroyed.
Wind dies down 11pm.



WEDS 5TH SEPT 1666
Wind changes direction.
Many fires put out.



THURS 6TH SEPT 1666
Last fires extinguished.
